AND UPON the court reading: the Claim Form; the Particulars of Claim; the Application notice in form N244 all dated 16 April 2018, and the witness statement of Ian Pugh dated 16 April 2018 and its exhibits.

AND UPON the Court having granted an interim injunction against the First and Second Defendants in these proceedings by separate order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The interim injunction granted today will be reviewed and reconsidered by the High Court on Thursday 26 April, not before 10:30 a.m. or such other date as the Court office shall allocate.
2. There shall be an order for substituted service upon the First Defendant of the proceedings, the Claimant's application notice dated 16 April 2018, the Statement of Ian Pugh dated 16 April 2018 and this order in the same form as that set out in the injunction order and any further documents served by the Claimants in these proceedings. Any documents so served shall be deemed to have been served on the First Defendant:
 - 1) In the case of service by email on the First Defendant:
 - (a) if the email is sent on a business day before 4.30pm, on that day;
 - (b) in any other case, the next business day after the day on which it was sent.
 - 2) In case the case of service by post on the First Defendant (if email service has not been successfully effected) the second day after it is posted provided that day is a business day and, if it is not, the next business day thereafter.
3. Save as set out in the Injunction Order, service of the proceedings, evidence and applications on the Second and Third Defendants is dispensed with.
4. The costs of the Claimant's application are reserved.
